Ask God to forgive specific sins where you know you've failed Him. Forgive and release to God those who have sinned against you. Set your will to walk in forgiveness.

Lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

Pray for a hedge of protection and put on the whole armor of God: The belt of truth The breastplate of righteousness The shoes of peace and preparation The shield of faith The helmet of salvation The sword of the Spirit
