1 Peter 2:9

But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light.

Our greatest declaration is His praise.

Revelation 4:11

You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power: for you have created all things, and for your pleasure they are and were created.

Six Ways to Engage in a Declaration Celebration:

1. Lifting Our Hands (Yadah & Towdah)

Psalms 63:4

I will praise you as long as I live, and in your name I will lift up my hands.

2. Kneeling Before God (Barak)

Psalms 95:6

Come, let us bow down in worship, let us kneel before the LORD our Maker...

3. Lifting a Shout (Shabach)

Psalms 71:23

My lips will shout for joy when I sing praise to you - I, whom you have redeemed.

4. Dancing and Clapping Our Hands (Hallal)

Psalms 145:7

They will celebrate your abundant goodness and joyfully sing of your righteousness.

5. Singing (Tehillah)

Psalms 13:6

I will sing to the LORD, for he has been good to me.

6. Playing an Instrument (Zamar)

Psalms 149:3

Let them praise his name with dancing and make music to him with tambourine and harp.

• God's enemies will always try and stop the celebration.

Luke 19:36-40
