Psalm 96:3

Six Main Spiritual Disciplines

1. Prayer

Prayer declares, "I'm helpless without God."

Luke 9:18

One day Jesus left the crowds to pray alone. Only his disciples were with him, and he asked them, "Who do people say I am?" 19 "Well," they replied, "some say John the Baptist, some say Elijah, and others say you are one of the other ancient prophets risen from the dead." 20 Then he asked them, "But who do you say I am?" Peter replied, "You are the Messiah sent from God!"

2. Bible Study

Bible study declares, "I want to know God's will."

John 8:31

Jesus said to the people who believed in him, "You are truly my disciples if you remain faithful to my teachings."

Hosea 4:6

"...my people are destroyed from lack of knowledge."

3. Holiness

Holiness declares, "I fear God."

John 15:8

When you produce much fruit, you are my true disciples. This brings great glory to my Father.

4. Evangelism

Evangelism declares, "I care about what God cares about."

Matthew 9:37

He said to his disciples, "The harvest is great, but the workers are few."

5. Good Works

Good works declare, “I want God to use me.”

Matthew 15:36

Then he took the seven loaves and the fish, thanked God for them, and broke them into pieces. He gave them to the disciples, who distributed the food to the crowd.

6. Kingdom Relationships

Kingdom relationship declares, “His people are my people.”

John 13:35

“Your love for one another will prove to the world that you are my disciples.”

Mark 8:34

Then he called the crowd to him along with his disciples and said: “Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me.”
