Part Two - Giving Our Report

Isaiah 53:1

Who has believed our report? And to whom has the arm of the LORD been revealed?

Our report gives God all the praise.

Psalm 107:2

Let the redeemed of the LORD say so, whom he has redeemed from trouble...

Our report puts Satan in his place.

Revelation 12:11

And they have defeated him by the blood of the Lamb and by their testimony. And they did not love their lives so much that they were afraid to die.

Our report shows people the way.

Romans 10:14

But how can they call on him to save them unless they believe in him? And how can they believe in him if they have never heard about him? And how can they hear about him unless someone tells them?

How to Prepare a Report Card

1. Write your story into a 3-minute testimony.

Luke 8:39

“Return home and tell how much God has done for you.” So the man went away and told all over town how much Jesus had done for him.

2. Refuse to be ashamed.

2 Timothy 1:8

So do not be ashamed of the testimony about our Lord...

Matthew 10:33, But whoever disowns me before others, I will disown before my Father in heaven.

3. Share it every chance you get.

Psalm 71:15-18

I will tell everyone about your righteousness. All day long I will proclaim your saving power, though I am not skilled with words. 16 I will praise your mighty deeds, O Sovereign LORD. I will tell everyone that you alone are just. 17 O God, you have taught me from my earliest childhood, and I constantly tell others about the wonderful things you do. 18 Now that I am old and gray, do not abandon me, O God. Let me proclaim your power to this new generation, your mighty miracles to all who come after me.
