Pt. 3 - Moving On

Open - JoJo's Reception: Footloose and Cupid Shuffle

1 Peter 2:1-2, So get rid of all evil behavior. Be done with all deceit, hypocrisy, jealousy, and all unkind speech. 2 Like newborn babies, you must crave pure spiritual milk so that you will grow into a full experience of salvation.

Note - Peter's life is a character study in how to move on!

He knows how to dance between the elbows.

Example - How many times should I forgive someone?
(Matthew 18)

- To move on, we must move beyond men.

Note - Whether they failed you or formed you - they're just men!

Matthew 16:13-16, When Jesus came to the region of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, "Who do people say the Son of Man is?" 14 They replied, "Some say John the Baptist; others say Elijah; and still others, Jeremiah or one of the prophets." 15 "But what about you?" he asked. "Who do you say I am?" 16 Simon Peter answered, "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God."

Note - Moving beyond men leads to the keys of the Kingdom of heaven.

Example - Me and Jesse

- To move on, we must move beyond moments.

Matthew 17:1-8, After six days Jesus took with him Peter, James and John the brother of James, and led them up a high mountain by themselves. 2 There he was transfigured before them. His face shone like the sun, and his clothes became as white as the light. 3 Just then there appeared before them Moses and Elijah, talking with Jesus. 4 Peter said to Jesus, "Lord, it is good for us to be here. If you wish, I will put up three shelters - one for you, one for Moses and one for Elijah." 5 While he was still speaking, a bright cloud covered them, and a voice from the cloud said, "This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased. Listen to him!" 6 When the disciples heard this, they fell facedown to the ground, terrified. 7 But Jesus came and touched them. "Get up," he said. "Don't be afraid." 8 When they looked up, they saw no one except Jesus.

Note - If we don't move past a moment of transfiguration, we will never get to the moment of resurrection. Jesus didn't come to impress you, He came to possess you!

Example - Skyscrapers / 180

· To move on, we must move beyond mistakes.

Note - In pride, Peter had declared he would never fail Jesus, but in weakness he had denied Christ three times.

Matthew 26:33, Peter said to him, "Even if everyone else abandons you, I never will."

Matthew 26:74, Then Peter began to curse and swear with an oath, "I don't know the man!" Just then a rooster crowed.

John 21:17, The third time he said to him, "Simon son of John, do you love me?" Peter was hurt because Jesus asked him the third time "Do you love me?" He said

asked him the third time, "Do you love me?" He said, "Lord, you know all things; you know that I love you." Jesus said, "Feed my sheep."

Note - The charcoal fire

For all 3 times Peter denied Him, Christ gave him an opportunity to affirm his love.

Living in your failure leaves us fishing for the wrong things!

- To move on, we must move beyond misconceptions.

Note - We make a lot of assumptions about God. He won't fit in your box!

Acts 10:15, But the voice spoke again: "Do not call something unclean if God has made it clean."

Note - God wants us to move into a new testament.

Colossians 2:17, For these rules are only shadows of the reality yet to come. And Christ himself is that reality.

- To move on, we must move beyond our masquerade.

Note - Sometimes we don't move on because we want to fit in.

Galatians 2:11-14, But when Peter came to Antioch, I opposed him in public, because he was clearly wrong. 12 Before some men who had been sent by James arrived there, Peter had been eating with the Gentile believers. But after these men arrived, he drew back and would not eat with the Gentiles, because he was afraid of those who were in favor of circumcising them. 13 The other Jewish believers also started acting like cowards along with Peter; and even Barnabas was swept along by their cowardly action. 14 When I saw that they were not walking a straight path in line with the truth of the gospel, I said to Peter in front of them all, "You are a Jew, yet you

have been living like a Gentile, not like a Jew. How, then, can you try to force Gentiles to live like Jews?"

Note - God can't bless who you pretend to be.

- What do you need to move beyond? It's time to bust a move.

Hebrews 12:1, So then, let us rid ourselves of everything that gets in the way, and of the sin which holds on to us so tightly, and let us run with determination the race that lies before us.
