Pt. 4 - Develop and Defend

Our values must be developed.

Galatians 4:18-19, It is fine to be zealous, provided the purpose is good, and to be so always and not just when I am with you. 19 My dear children, for whom I am again in the pains of childbirth until Christ is formed in you...

Note - Values work like an ethical muscle memory.

Example - Golf (The ethical hook or slice.)

Stewardship - Over time we practice sticking with a budget, saving for what we want, praying before spending, etc.

Note - Practice what doesn't come natural to you until comes natural to you!

Example - Evangelism

Note - Like photographs, values are often developed in dark places.

2 Corinthians 12:9, Each time he said, "My grace is all you need. My power works best in weakness." So now I am glad to boast about my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ can work through me.

Example - Sobriety

Ephesians 4:27, and do not leave room for the Devil.

Note - That sense of value came from very dark places I don't ever intend to revisit!

Our values must be defended.

Note - When your biblical values are questioned, defend them!

2 Timothy 2:25, Be humble when you correct people who oppose you. Maybe God will lead them to turn to him and learn the truth.

Note - We often try to clean the fish before we catch them

Example - The Romanian's value system

Note - The greatest threat to our values isn't someone who doesn't share them. The greatest threat to our values is us not valuing them enough.

Example - Rehoboam's gold shields
