

# Hunger Pains

## Pt. 3 – A Seat at the Table

Note – but before we take our seat, let's set the table so to speak

### Food Pyramid

**Deuteronomy 8:3**, Man does not live on bread alone but on every word that comes from the mouth of the Lord

This food on the table represents all those things. (It all works together)

- We try to pick and choose
- We want all that God has, without doing all that he says
- He can't be Lord of some things. He's either Lord over all or nothing.
- God is not interested in being your personal assistant!

**Deuteronomy 11:26-28**, See, I am setting before you today a blessing and a curse- the blessing if you obey the commands of the Lord your God that I am giving you today; the curse if you disobey the commands of the Lord your God and turn from the way that I command you today by following other gods, which you have not known

- God's Blessings, Promises, and Provision follow obedience

**Deuteronomy 28:1-2**, If you fully obey the Lord your God and carefully follow all his commands I give you today, the Lord your God will set you high above all the nations of the earth. All these blessings will come on you and accompany you if you obey the Lord your God.

- Obedience is what nourishes our spirit and provides health for our soul.

**The Table** – The Table represents communion with God, his plan, his purpose, and his Provision.

**Psalms 23:5**, You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies. You anoint my head with oil, my cup overflows.

- It won't sustain us there!

**1 Corinthians 10:21**, you cannot have a part in both the Lord's table and the table of demons.

- Everything we need is at this table!!

**Gen 2:18**, the Lord said, "it is not good for man to be alone. **PASS THE Potatoes**

- Even though I'm here, something is missing.
- Spiritual Growth doesn't happen in isolation
- When God sets the Table, he also assigns the seats.

**Romans 12:5**, so in Christ we, though many, form one body, and each member belongs to all the others.

- To operate and function as the body, we have to be together.

**Ephesians 4:16**, From him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows, and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work.

- This is a picture of the body of Christ. Family, Fellowship, companionship, connection, God has placed that appetite and hunger within us, it's up to us to take our seat at the table.
