Pt. 2 - Wrapping Up Assignments

- We need to strive to be able to say, "That's a wrap" with the assignments we are given.

Psalm 37:4, Delight yourself in the LORD, and He will give you the desires of your heart.

Ephesians 2:10, For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

- Wrapping up our God-given assignments makes us Christ-like.

Isaiah 50:7, Because the Sovereign LORD helps me, I will not be disgraced. Therefore have I set my face like flint, and I know I will not be put to shame.

Hebrews 12:2, Let us keep our eyes fixed on Jesus, on whom our faith depends from beginning to end. He did not give up because of the cross! On the contrary, because of the joy that was waiting for him, he thought nothing of the disgrace of dying on the cross, and he is now seated at the right side of God's throne.

Jeremiah 29:11, "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."

How to Wrap Up Your Goals

1. Write your goals down.

Habakkuk 2:2, Then the LORD told me: "I will give you my message in the form of a vision. Write it clearly enough to be read at a glance.

2. Take intentional steps in pursuit of your goals. God always favors the aggressive and persistent!

Psalm 37:23, The steps of a man are ordered by the LORD who takes delight in his journey.

Proverbs 14:15, A simple man believes anything, but a prudent man gives thought to his steps.

Matthew 15:22-28, A Canaanite woman from that vicinity came to him, crying out, "Lord, Son of David, have mercy on me! My daughter is suffering terribly from demon-possession." Jesus did not answer a word. So his disciples came to him and urged him, "Send her away, for she keeps crying out after us." He answered, "I was sent only to the lost sheep of Israel." The woman came and knelt before him. "Lord, help me!" she said. He replied, "It is not right to take the children's bread and toss it to their dogs." "Yes, Lord," she said, "but even the dogs eat the crumbs that fall from their masters' table." Then Jesus answered, "Woman, you have great faith! Your

request is granted.” And her daughter was healed from that very hour.

3. Stay motivated.

1 Samuel 30:6, ...but David encouraged himself in the LORD his God.

Philippians 3:14, I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus.

4. Stay accountable.

Proverbs 15:22, Plans fail for lack of counsel but with many advisers they succeed.
