# Elevation Pt. 2 - Elevate Your Eyes

Romans 6:4, ...just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may walk in newness of life.

### • Elevation starts with our eyes.

*Isaiah 6:1*, In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord. He was sitting on his throne, high and exalted, and his robe filled the whole Temple.

# **How to Elevate Our Vision for the World**
