- **Change your language.**

Proverbs 18:21

- **See everything through the lens of 'us.'**

Philippians 2:3

Instead of being motivated by selfish ambition or vanity, each of you should, in humility, be moved to treat one another as more important than yourself.

- **Lend the strength of your individuality to the collective good.**

Proverbs 21:17

4. Fa - Spending Time Together

Amos 3:3

5. Sol - Consideration

Philippians 2:4

Don't be concerned only about your own interests, but also be concerned about the interests of others.

- **Be thoughtful.**

1 Peter 3:7

If you are a husband, you should be thoughtful of your wife.

- **Be helpful.**

Genesis 2:18

Haggai 1:7

6. La - Intimacy

Hebrews 13:4

- **Sexual intimacy in marriage is a gift from God.**

Proverbs 5:15-19

16 Drink water from your own well - share your love only with your wife. Why spill the water of your springs in the streets, having sex with just anyone? 17 You should reserve it for yourselves. Never share it with strangers. 18 Let your wife be a fountain of blessing for you. Rejoice in the wife of your youth. 19 She is a loving deer, a graceful doe. Let her breasts satisfy you always. May you always be captivated by her love.

- **It is a way to serve the needs of our spouse.**

1 Corinthians 7:3

The husband should fulfill his wife's sexual needs, and the wife should fulfill her husband's needs.

- **It is a deterrent to temptation.**

1 Corinthians 7:5

Do not deprive each other of sexual relations unless you both agree to refrain from sexual intimacy for a limited time so you can give yourselves more completely to prayer. Afterward, you should come together again so that Satan won't be able to tempt you because of your lack of self-control.
