## 3 WAYS to take YOUR CITY

### 1. KNOW GOD IS FOR YOU

#### **Romans 8:31**

"If God is for us, who can be against us

#### **Joshua 6:16 NLT**

"The seventh time around, as the priests sounded the long blast on their horns, Joshua commanded the people, "Shout! For the Lord has given you the city!"

#### **Joshua 6:20 NLT**

"When the people heard the sound of the rams' horns, they shouted as loud as they could. Suddenly, the walls of Jericho collapsed, and the Israelites charged straight into the town and captured it."

**Praising God will position you for victory over your problems.**

### 2. BE OUTSIDE OF THE WALLS

#### **Joshua 6:1 NLT**

"Now the gates of Jericho were tightly shut because the people were afraid of the Israelites. No one was allowed to go out or in."

#### **Isaiah 61:1**

"The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me, Because the Lord has anointed me to bring good news to the afflicted; He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to captives and freedom to prisoners."

**God wants you to storm the gates of your city, but you can't storm the gates if you are stuck behind bars.**

#### **Joshua 6:2-3**

“But the Lord said to Joshua, “I have given you Jericho, its king, and all its strong warriors. You and your fighting men should march around the town once a day for six days.”

#### **Joshua 6:5 NLT**

“When you hear the priests give one long blast on the rams’ horns, have all the people shout as loud as they can. Then the walls of the town will collapse, and the people can charge straight into the town.”

#### **Joshua 1:9 NIV**

"Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go.”
