What Good Sense Teaches Us to Do with the 90%:

1. Live within your means.

Proverbs 21:20

Wise people live in wealth and luxury, but stupid people spend their money as fast as they get it.

Hebrews 13:5

Your conduct must be free from the love of money and you must be content with what you have, for he has said, "I will never leave you and I will never abandon you."

1 Timothy 6:6

A godly life brings huge profits to people who are content with what they have.

2. Live by a budget.

Proverbs 27:23-26

Know the state of your flocks, and put your heart into caring for your herds, 24 for riches don't last forever, and the crown might not be passed to the next generation. 25 After the hay is harvested and the new crop appears and the mountain grasses are gathered in, 26 your sheep will provide wool for clothing, and your goats will provide the price of a field.

Proverbs 21:5

Good planning and hard work lead to prosperity, but hasty shortcuts lead to poverty.

3. Get out of debt.

Proverbs 22:7

The rich rule over the poor, and the borrower is slave to the lender.

4. Establish an emergency fund.

Proverbs 6:6-11

5. Make safe, sound investments.

Proverbs 13:11

6. Leave an inheritance.

Proverbs 13:22

Good people leave an inheritance to their grandchildren, but the wealth of sinners is stored away for a righteous person.

Proverbs 20:21
